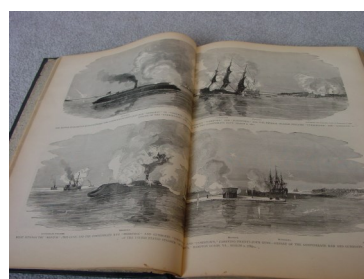
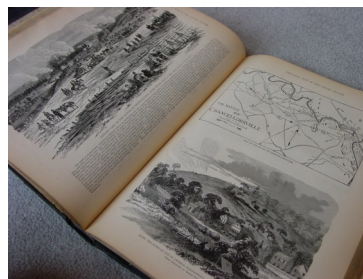
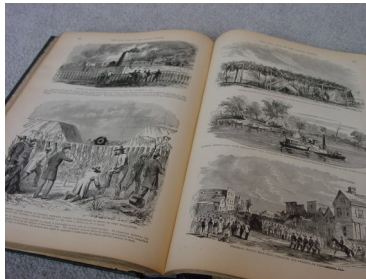
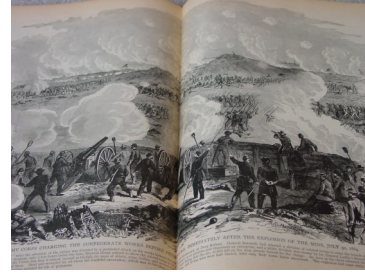
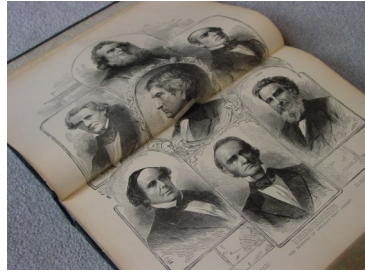
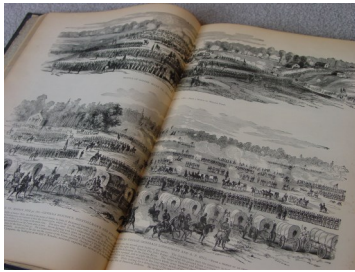
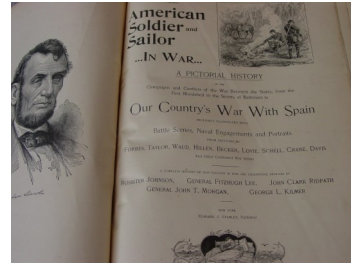
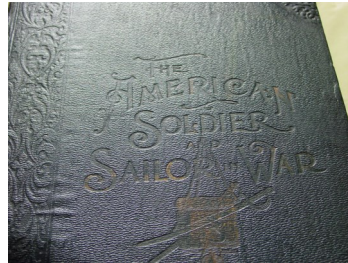
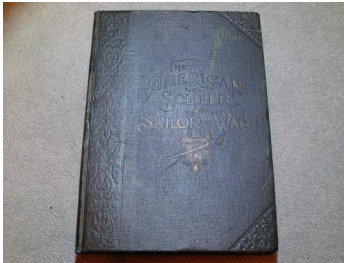


“The American Soldier and Sailor in War”
