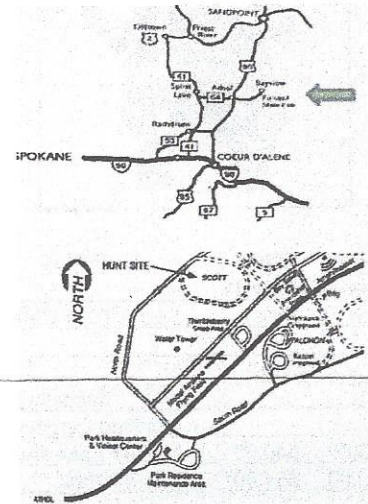

REMINDER OF THE MAIN HUNT RULES:

1. No hunting in the hunt fields until the hunt chairman gives the okay.
2. Only one detector may be used-pinpointers are allowed.
3. Digging tools will be checked-maximum width of 3/8 inch. **FILL ALL HOLES!**
4. No one other than the contestants or officials allowed on the hunt fields.
5. The remaining rules may be found in your packets.

CAMPING AND VEHICLE INFORMATION-PLEASE READ!

1. Every vehicle must pay the parking fee at the park office-\$5 per day per vehicle. A yearly pass is available for Idaho State Parks. It is \$40 per year. Idaho residents can get a great discount at the DMV.
2. You must show proof of vehicle payment before you can pick up your hunt packet.
3. Campers pay a \$17 fee per campsite per night stayed. We're sorry, but Farragut has raised their price for the event, so we had to raise this price. This is to be paid to the club either on the form or at registration. We will need a head count of how many people are camping at each campsite for how many nights at registration. **PLEASE WRITE THAT ON YOUR REGISTRATION SLIP.**

Hunt Raffle

The 6 for \$5 price is good with mailed in registration or at the hunt. Tickets will be available at the hunt. First prize is a Treasure Chest featuring a \$5 GOLD COIN and more. Second to fifth prize are 2016 30th Anniversary Silver Eagles. These are beautiful MS70 slabbed coins! We will also be raffling a new Multi Frequency Garrett Apex.

Saturday Hunts:

The Mother Lode Hunt will be about 100 targets per entrant. There will be clad coins planted and tokens for silver coins and prizes. The main prizes will be a detector and 2 gold grams.

The Eureka Hunt will have great prizes (including a detector and gold coin) on special tokens.

The Kid's hunts will be similar to last year's. Awards will be given right after the hunts.

The Grubstake Hunt will be about Quarters. There will be at least 60 targets per entrant and they'll all be for Quarters-Silver and Clad.

The Silver Dollar Saloon Hunt will be held in the early evening, so we can have time to get to the saloon!

Sunday Hunts:

The Paydirt Hunt will have 3000 Halves planted in the field. There will also be tokens good for SILVER and other prizes including 2 pinpointers.

There will be at least 114 targets per entrant in the Old Timer's Hunt. Tokens will be good for at least 400 silver and 5 gold coins. You'll feel like an Old Timer by the end of this one!

What else will be happening over the weekend to keep you out of trouble? Another Trivia Game this year, but it may be a little different. On Friday night, we will have a social hour with cookies and coffee.

On Saturday night, we'll be hosting a free Chicken dinner. We'll supply the main course, sides, drinks, and dessert. We'll also have utensils, paper plates, napkins, and condiments. Donations are appreciated. We will have the Plinko board set up and lots of other entertainment.
