Hunt Rules Form Agreement

Hunt Field Rules:

- Hunt Master is totally in charge of the hunt
- Registered hunters must wear hunt registration badge while on the hunt field
- No walking across the Hunt Field while getting to your hunt field line-up position
- No hunting in hunt fields between hunts
- All trash recovered during the hunt must be put in a target recovery pouch and be removed from the hunt field
- All holes dug to recover targets must be filled once the target has been removed— anyone not filling holes will be asked to leave the hunt
- Failure to show respect to your fellow hunters; the use of foul language; or inappropriate behavior will result in the forfeiture of your remaining hunt fees and you will be asked to leave

Metal Detector Rules:

- Entrants must provide their own metal detector and target recovery tools
- All hunt participants must wear headphones
- Stock detectors and coils must be used
- No search coil larger than twelve inches is allowed
- Digging tools/knives must be 6 inches or shorter
- No extended handle digging tools allowed
