



## Ozarks 4 – Spring Silver Hunt- May 11<sup>th</sup>, Atkins, AR

Directions - Take Atkins exit off I-40 and go south on Church St. Continue past Main St. (Hwy 64) and turn left on SE 4<sup>th</sup> St. Two blocks down on right. Atkins City Pool.

Gold Coin Scramble - also called a Gate Hunt or Progressive Hunt. There are three areas. Everyone starts in the first area and must find the required targets to progress to the second area and so on. First prize will be a gold coin. We will pay at least 5 places.

Kid's Hunt – there will be two Kid's Hunt areas – one for kids with detectors that can find and dig a target and the other for those that cannot. Kid's Hunt is free with an adult paid entry.

Indian hunt – all entries will go into the hunt. Targets will be Indian head pennies and buffalo nickels. There will also be 1/10 oz. Indian Head silver rounds buried. The prizes will be 1 oz. Indian Head silver rounds.

Main Hunt - all entries go for silver in the ground – dimes, quarters, half dollars and silver dollars. All of our prizes will be donated. The club is supplying 13 silver rounds from the money we raised from the raffles last time.
